## SPEYSIDE

	ABV
1. <b>GLENFIDDICH SPECIAL 12YO</b> Fresh and fragrant nose with hints of pear. A distinctive, well-balanced taste with rich fruit flavours, subtle pine and slight peatiness. It has a long, lingering finish.	40%
2. <b>GLENFIDDICH 18YO</b> Aromas of rich, ripe orchard fruits. The 18 year old richly delivers luxurious dried fruit, candy peel and dates overlaid with elegant oak.	40%
3. <b>BALVENIE DOUBLEWOOD 12YO</b> Smooth and mellow with beautifully combined flavours, nutty sweetness, cinnamon spiciness and delicately proportioned layers of sherry.	40%
4. <b>BALVENIE CARIBBEAN CASK 14YO</b> Rich, sweet and creamy toffee, delightfully smooth honey, finished with some fresh, tropical fruit notes.	43%
5. <b>MONKEY SHOULDER</b> Busy, complex and wonderfully weighted. Orangey-citrus softened by demerara, toffee and vanilla.	40%
6. <b>ABERLOUR 10YO</b> Fresh fruity aromas of early autumn apples and pears. An exceptionally smooth and creamy malt with spicy-sweet nutmeg and honey.	40%
7. <b>CRAGGANMORE 12YO</b> Mouthfilling. A full, sweet start, followed by some astringency and a short, bitter finish. Some herbal flavours and dry sherry.	40%
8. <b>GLEN GRANT</b> Inspired by James 'The Major' Grant, this easy drinking single malt shows a creamy, fruity touch on the palate with a hint of a spicy, nutty finish.	40%
9. <b>DALWHINNIE 15YO</b> Heather honey sweetness and a subtle dry smokiness on the finish. From the highest distillery in Scotland.	43%

## SPEYSIDE

ABV

### 10. THE GLENLIVET 12YO

40%

Combines tropical fruit flavours of pineapple and banana, with a floral aroma. The fresh palate develops into a soft finish with notes of vanilla.

### 11. KNOCKANDO 12YO

43%

Especially delicate, fruity and subtle Speyside malt. Smooth but complex layers of flowery, nutty and slightly smoky notes. Light and easy drinking style.

### 12. MACALLAN GOLD

40%

A deep, rich, deliciously smooth and well-rounded flavour with a slight sweetness and touch of sherry and wood.

### 13. SINGLETON OF DUFFTOWN

40%

This smooth, naturally rich malt has sweet, fruity notes and lingering, pleasurable warmth.

## LOWLAND

### 14. AUCHENTOSHAN 12YO

40%

Ripe gooseberries, sweet creamy vanilla and a hint of oak with a warm, smooth and delicate taste.

### 15. AUCHENTOSHAN THREE WOOD

43%

Rich, ripe dark fruits, like a Black Forest gâteau with a dark treacle and toffee finish.

### 16. GLENKINCHIE 12YO

43%

Soft and gentle with a citrus freshness and a mild, malty finish. Edinburgh's local malt whisky.

## WEST

### 17. LOCH FYNE WHISKY

40%

"At the workshop on the shores of Loch Fyne this unique blend has been produced from 22 years of speaking with customers. They tell us everything we need to know and, like whisky, the skill of listening improves with age."

### 18. LOCH FYNE LIVING CASK

## HIGHLAND

### 19. GLENGOYNE 10YO

A soft, sweet and slightly herbal 10 year old malt with a rich barley palate. Clean and dry.

### 20. DALMORE 12YO

Toasty and coffee rich on the nose with winter spices and Seville orange marmalade on the palate. A rich and creamy 12 year old.

### 21. GLENMORANGIE ORIGINAL

A nose of vanilla fudge and toffee which transfer onto the palate, accompanied by hints of orchard fruits. Scotland's most popular single malt!

### 22. OBAN 14YO

An easy drinking whisky with sweet, malty, fruit flavours.

43%

### 23. OLD PULTENEY 12YO

From the most northerly distillery on the Scottish mainland, this malt has a hint of sea air on the nose with a lightly sherried and slightly salty palate.

## ISLAND

### 24. HIGHLAND PARK 12YO

A great all-rounder with a wonderful balance between heather sweetness and dry peat smoke.

### 25. ISLE OF ARRAN 10YO

A rush of vanilla sweetness gives way to the fruits of slow distillation – kiwi, banana, melon. Classic citrus and sweet oak palate.

### 26. ISLE OF JURA 10YO

A gently smoked island malt with an underlying spice which warms the palate.

### 27. ISLE OF JURA SUPERSTITION

Bearing the historical Egyptian Ankh cross, this is a blend of finest aged Jura single malts creating a unique style with tastes of spice, honey, pine and peat.

### 28. TALISKER 10YO

Intense, peppery, smoky flavours with a lingering sweet peaty finish. The only distillery on the Isle of Skye.

## ISLAY

ABV

### 29. ARDBEG 10YO

46%

Bursting with intense smoky fruit. Peat infused with zesty lemon and lime. A creamy lingering palate ending with espresso, liquorice root and tarry smoke, with soft barley and pear.

### 30. LAGAVULIN 16YO

43%

A peat explosion gives way to a sweet, oily sensation with one of the longest finishes to be found in Scotch whisky.

### 31. LAPHROAIG 10YO

40%

Unique and distinctive. Powerful smoke is accompanied by a medicinal, iodine flavour.

### 32. BOWMORE 12YO

40%

A lemon and honey bouquet with the distinctive Bowmore smokiness. Warm and delicious on the palate with subtle dark chocolate flavours.

### 33. PORT CHARLOTTE SCOTTISH BARLEY

50%

Heavily peated, soft, yet big on flavour, no added colouring and no chill filtering allowing the valuable oils/flavour to deliver a truly outstanding malt.

### 34. CAOL ILA 12YO

43%

A lighter style of Islay malt with a peaty nose and distinct floral notes. It is often described as tasting slightly of seaweed. Smoky, salty, sweet with a dry peppery finish.

## GLASGOW & THE WEST

ABV

### 35. LOCH Fyne GIN

42%

At the heart of this gin is juniper, coriander and orange peel. To this is added sea buckthorn, heather pearls, lemon peel and traditional milk thistle seed. Light, balanced and a joy to drink.

### 36. KINTyre

43%

A beautifully blended spirit using carefully selected botanicals which reflect the unique position on the east coast of the Kintyre peninsula. Delicate floral notes and citrus body, with a juniper and spice finish.

### 37. HENDRICK'S

41.4%

Distilled in Girvan. A distinctively light, sweet and floral gin, made with the addition of cucumber and Bulgarian rose. A slice of cucumber is the ideal garnish.

### 38. MAKAR GLASGOW GIN

43%

Glasgow's only gin is handcrafted in small batches and distilled in a copper pot still by the name of Annie. The gin is bright, vibrant and well balanced.

## EDINBURGH

ABV

### 39. EDINBURGH GIN CANNONBALL

57.2%

Punchy yet balanced Navy Strength gin. Strong juniper and lemon flavours, finishing with lingering spice.

### 40. EDINBURGH GIN SEASIDE

43%

Inspired by East Coast beaches near Edinburgh, a unique London dry-style gin defined by juniper, soft salinity and sweet notes.

### 41. PICKERING'S GIN

42%

The first exclusive gin distillery to be established in Edinburgh for over 150 years. A rounded rich and warming gin, with the accent on juniper, ideal with an invigorating slice of pink grapefruit.

### 42. DAFFY'S

43.4%

Distilled in a copper pot still. Smooth and vibrant spice with oaky mouthfeel, fine juniper and Lebanese mint and a long, buttery, warm, elegant finish.



# SCOTTISH GIN



## FIFE

ABV

### 43. EDEN MILL OAK

42%

A throwback to a bygone era, in the 19th century it was the most popular gin made on Eden Mill's site. This release is matured in oak-aged beer casks for a few weeks and carries hints of vanilla and toasted caramel.

### 44. EDEN MILL HOP

46%

Light and delicate coriander and complex floral tones on the nose, spiced grapefruit, bitter lemon and lime rind on the palate, then hoppy fresh citrus notes soften out to green grass meadows.

### 45. EDEN MILL LOVE

42%

It's all in the name: in 2015 the aim was to make a Valentine's Day spirit; the famous pink gin has floral and warm berry notes. "More beautiful than a bouquet of roses and more romantic than a Barry White classic."

### 46. DARNLEY'S VIEW

40%

Darnley's View is made in the time-honoured way by re-distilling the botanicals with a four-times distilled neutral grain spirit. Principally juniper, lemon peel, elderflower, angelica root and coriander.

### 47. DARNLEY'S VIEW SPICED

42.7%

Based on the classic View recipe with a selection of ten berries, seeds, peels and roots. Juniper, cinnamon and nutmeg give a warm exotic twist.

## PERTHSHIRE

ABV

### 48. HEATHER ROSE

40%

Strathearn is Scotland's first micro-distillery, and this gin's beautiful mahogany colour hides a magical secret. Botanicals include juniper, coriander seeds, orange peel, lemon peel, liquorice root, rose petals and purple heather flowers. Fragrant, floral and light, sweet yet spicy.

## ANGUS

ABV

### 49. KIRSTY'S GIN

43%

Grown, distilled and bottled on the Arbikie Highland Estate in a true farm-to-bottle operation. Botanics chosen by their Master Distiller, Kirsty Black, create notes of kelp, carline thistle and blueberry.

## CAIRNGORMS & SPEYSIDE

ABV

### 50. CROSSBILL

43.8%

Distilled in Aviemore, named after a native Scots bird which can be found in the Caledonian Pine Forests of Scotland. A handcrafted, dry gin.

### 51. CAORUNN

41.8%

Distilled in Cromdale. The handcrafted infusion is created using only the finest grain spirit, natural Scottish water and 11 Celtic botanical ingredients.

## THE NORTH

ABV

### 52. ROCK ROSE

41.5%

Distilled in Dunnet Bay, the gin gets its wonderful flavour from carefully selected local and traditional botanicals which include rose root, rowan berries and sea buckthorn.

### 53. ROCK ROSE NAVY

57%

Limited edition navy-strength version of Rock Rose, made with botanicals foraged from cliffs and forests.

### 54. GORDON CASTLE

43%

From Elgin, this gin is crisp, elegant and refreshing with a lovely clean palate. Subtle notes of lavender and garden mint helps promote its clean refreshing character.

## SCOTTISH GIN



### THE HEBRIDES

ABV

#### 55. SHETLAND REEL

43%

Distilled with only local botanicals to create a gin that is completely unique and embodies the place where it originates, this original recipe has a hint of locally-grown apple mint.

#### 56. SHETLAND REEL OCEAN SENT

49%

Features native bladderwrack seaweed from the coastline.

#### 57. SHETLAND REEL SIMMER

49%

This summer-inspired gin has a strong juniper and sweet orange nose, with a hint of liquorice flavour on the palate.

#### 58. THE BOTANIST

46%

The only Islay dry gin is made up of many classic aromatics – orris root, cassia bark and coriander. Augmented with a harvest of 22 local botanicals that are all hand-picked by the expert foraging team from the windswept hills, peat bogs and Atlantic shores.
